

Euro Mediterranean Experts Group (EMEG)


- 1. WHAT IS EMEG: EMEG is the Med-Spring "think tank" constituted by more than 40 experts coming from EU members and Mediterranean Partner Countries. The WEB community is also a "virtual" partner in EMEG contributing through open consultation and online forums.
- 2. Themes and areas to be addressed: EMEG carries out activities of stocktaking, assessment and analysis on Water, Food and Energy. For each major theme, emphasis is given to:
- Water: managing water scarcity, water use efficiency, water saving, use of non-conventional water, water quality, water management, water governance.
- Food: food security and safety, biodiversities, health, fisheries and aquaculture, food-chain in pre to post-harvesting, organic farming and products.
- **Energy**: energy efficiency, solar energy, photovoltaic, wind, bio-energy, applications.

EMEG experts – for the theme under their responsibility – will have the following main tasks:

- Task 1: Stocktaking and valorisation of research, with the aim of facilitating uptake of research results and enhancing impact in relation to the main thematic challenges.
- Task 2: Stocktaking and analysis of research policies in the Euro-Mediterranean region.
- Task 3: Developing a holistic vision of societal challenges to enhance a logical and feasible integrated research approach to the above themes.
